

NORTHEAST REGIONAL ALLIANCE – MEDPREP SCHOLARS PROGRAM

The MedPrep Scholars Program is for college freshmen who are interested in attending Medical School and who want to improve their chances for acceptance.

The MedPrep Scholars Program is a free, six week summer enrichment program for NJ and NYC residents. The program begins June 2010 and continues for 3 summers. It is an all day program and students must be available to complete all three phases of the program beginning with MedPrep 1 in June 2010, MedPrep 2, June 2011 and ending with MedPrep 3 beginning June 2012.

Students must be United States Citizens or a permanent resident. Student Visas are not accepted.

Permanent residents are required to demonstrate proof of status by providing a copy of both sides of their Green Card. All students must have completed a College Chemistry (I, II or both) and English Composition (I, II, or both)
